BACKGROUND

Prior to commencing pupillage, Hannah was a Senior Immigration Caseworker at Wilson Solicitors LLP, where she gained experience representing clients in the First Tier Tribunal and Upper Tribunal in complex immigration, asylum and criminal deportation appeals. She has worked extensively with vulnerable children

and adults, including victims of trafficking, torture and gender-based violence.

Hannah was formerly a Student Director of a project that assisted individuals with applications for Exceptional Case Funding, and a Co-founder of an organisation that provided general information about the UK asylum process to asylum-seekers living in the unofficial refugee camp in Calais.

She has also worked as a volunteer teaching assistant at the homelessness charity, Crisis UK, and at Cambridge House Law Centre, which specialises in housing and social welfare law.
